**PhD Students are required to fulfill the requirement below before taking the oral defence examination.**

Publication Requirements for Doctoral Thesis Defense:

To be eligible for the doctoral thesis defense, students must accumulate at least 6 points from the following activities related to their dissertation research:

- Book Chapter published in a book indexed by WoS (Web of Science) or Scopus (Applicable only to Social Sciences and Architecture fields): 6 points
- Article published or accepted for publication in a journal indexed by WoS (SCI, SSCI, SCI-E, AHCI) or the Scopus database:
  - Q1: 6 points
  - Q2: 6 points
  - Q3: 5 points
  - Q4: 4 points
- International Patent: 6 points
- National Patent: 4 points
